EXTRACTS FROM CHAPTER 150, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, THE HAWAII SEED LAW

§150-21 Definitions. As used in this chapter:

"Agricultural seed" includes the seed of grass, forage, cereal, and fiber crops and other kinds of seed commonly recognized within the State as agricultural seed and mixtures of these seed, and may include noxious weed seed.

"Vegetable seed" includes the seed of those crops which are grown in gardens and on truck farms and are generally known and sold under the name of vegetable seed in the State.

§150-29 Seed Licenses. A seed license from the department is required of:

- (1) Every person whose name and address are required on the label or who imports into the State for sale or resale, agricultural or vegetable seed for planting purposes.

- (2) Every person who opens any bag or container of agricultural or vegetable seed and sells the contents for planting purposes within the State.

Application for the license shall be made to the department in accordance with rules adopted by the department. All licenses shall expire on June 30 of each year.

EXTRACTS FROM CHAPTER 4-67, HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, SEED RULES

§4-67-17 Seed license.

- (a) Application for a seed license shall be made on a form provided by the department.

- (b) The license shall expire on June 30 of each year and may be renewed on or before July 1 of each year.

- (c) A fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be assessed for each license.
