

Coconut Rhinoceros Beetle Response Update
August 3-15, 2015

- **Detections**
 - On Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPH-HI)
 - 45 adults/0 larvae detected of 1981 adults/1970 larvae total detected since 12/23/2013.
 - Off Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPH-HI)
 - 10 adults/12 larvae detected of 149 adults total detected since 12/23/2013.
- **Surveillance**
 - No new delimiting survey barrel traps were placed and 117 trap services were conducted on 145 total barrel traps during this period.
 - 11 new delimiting survey panel traps were placed and 1,199 trap services were conducted on 2,842 total panel traps during this period.
 - 4 compost/mulch/green waste sites were visually surveyed for CRB presence during this period out of 349 compost/mulch/green waste piles surveyed to date.
 - No new CRB dead/damaged palms were detected and 1 dead or damaged palms was removed during this period.
- **Outreach**
 - A total of 120 persons were provided outreach information and materials during this reporting period out of a total of 61,433 persons contacted since CRB was first detected on 12/23/2013.
 - No confirmed CRB reports during this reporting period out of 878 reports to date since CRB was first detected was called in to the HDOA's 643-PEST hotline.
- **Beetle Fact:** Survey: There are two CAPS-approved survey methods for *O. rhinoceros*. Visual surveys may be used to detect larval or adult populations. A trap and lure combination may be used to detect adult populations.
