#### DIRECTIONS TO POAMOHO RESEARCH STATION

##### FROM Aiea Direction:

H2 turns into Wilikina Drive, which will turn into Kaukonahua Road (stay to left). Follow Kaukonahua Road, you will see a chain link fence on the right and signs that will lead you to the field day site.

##### From North Shore:

Take Kamehameha Highway / HI 83 towards Waialua. As you enter Haleiwa stay to the left and follow Joseph Leong Highway. At the top of the bridge, turn left onto Kamehameha Highway and follow the round about. Take the second exit on the round about towards Mokuleia. Follow that road until you see a blinking stop sign. Turn left and go up towards Kaukonahua Road. Follow this road until you see a chain link fence on the left and signs that will lead you to the field day site.
