- Paratuberculosis (Johne's disease) (*Mycobacterium avium paratuberculosis*) < 72 hours

- Q Fever (*Coxiella burnetti*) < 72 hours
- Rabies < 24 hours
- Screwworm, new world (*Cochliomyia hominivorax*) < 24 hours
- Screwworm, old world (*Chrysomya bezziana*) < 24 hours

Cattle diseases

- Bovine anaplasmosis (*Anaplasma marginale*, *A. centrale*) < 24 hours
- Bovine babesiosis (*Babesia bovis*, *B. bigemina*) < 72 hours
- Bovine brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*) < 24 hours
- Bovine genital campylobacteriosis (*Campylobacter fetus venerealis*) < 30 days
- Bovine spongiform encephalopathy < 24 hours
- Bovine tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis*) < 24 hours
- Cysticercosis (*Cysticercus bovis* metacestode stage of *Taenia saginata*) < 30 days
- Dermatophilosis (*Dermatophilus congolensis*) < 30 days
- Enzootic bovine leukosis < 30 days
- Haemorrhagic septicaemia (*Pasteurella multocida*) < 30 days
- Infectious bovine rhinotracheitis / infectious pustular vulvovaginitis < 30 days

- Trichomonosis (*Tritrichomonas (Trichomonas) foetus*) < 30 days

Sheep and Goat diseases

- Ovine epididymitis (*Brucella ovis*) < 72 hours
- Caprine and ovine brucellosis (*Brucella melitensis*, not *B. ovis*) < 24 hours
- Caprine arthritis/encephalitis < 30 days
- Contagious agalactia (*Mycoplasma agalactiae*, *M. capricolum capricolum*, *M. putrefaciens*, *M. mycoides mycoides*, *M. mycoides mycoides* LC) < 72 hours
- Contagious caprine pleuropneumonia (*M. capricolum capripneumoniae*) < 72 hours
- Enzootic abortion of ewes (*Chlamydia psittaci*) < 30 days
- Ovine pulmonary adenomatosis < 30 days

- Nairobi sheep disease < 72 hours
- Salmonellosis (*Salmonella abortus ovis*) < 30 days
- Scrapie < 72 hours
- Maedi-visna < 72 hours

- Enterovirus encephalomyelitis < 72 hours
- Porcine brucellosis (*Brucella suis*) < 24 hours
- Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome < 72 hours
- Transmissible gastroenteritis < 72 hours

- Trichinellosis (*Trichinella spiralis*) < 30 days

- Avian infectious bronchitis < 30 days

- Duck virus hepatitis < 72 hours
- Duck virus enteritis < 72 hours
- Fowl cholera (*Pasteurella multocida*) < 24 hours
- Fowl pox < 72 hours
