Farm Labor Statistics State of Hawaii, 2021

The count of all hired farm workers remained unchanged at 5,000 throughout the 2021 calendar year.¹ The number of hours worked in the reference weeks increased steadily during the year as compared to the corresponding periods in the previous year. Likewise, the gross wage rate paid to hired workers also increased progressively to a historical high of \$18.82 per hour during the week of October 10-16, 2021.

Additionally, Hawaii agriculturalists hired 211 guest workers on H-2A visas by the end of September 30, 2021, a 56% increase from the previous year. In contrast, overall H-2A visas issued in the U.S. were up by 21% in the same period. This trend reflects an ongoing national labor shortage of agricultural workers. The gross wage rate at the high-end range for guest workers was \$2.72 an hour lower than that for all hired farm workers.² The count for H-2A workers hired in Hawaii by agricultural classification were distributed as follows: coffee (6), apiculture (24), livestock (11) and general farm workers (170).
