Distribution of Farmland for Horticultural Crops State of Hawaii, 2022

According to the 2022 Census of Agriculture, Hawaii's total cropland was estimated at 158,053 acres. Of this total, 2,744 acres (1.7%) were cultivated with horticultural crops in the open, including floriculture, bedding plants, nursery, propagative materials, and sod. Additionally, Hawaii cultivated horticultural crops in controlled environment, such as greenhouses and other protective structures. Notably, a total of 20.7 million square feet of space was dedicated for this purpose. In terms of land area, cut flowers and cut florist greens emerged as the top commodities, both in the open (1,076 acres) and under glass or other protection (7.08 million square feet).

Chart 1: Distribution of Farmland for Horticultural Crops in the Open (Acres), Hawaii, 2022





Chart 2: Distribution for Horticultural Crops Under Glass or Other Protection (Square Feet), Hawaii, 2022
