## QUARANTINE ORDER NO. 133

### SWINE ENTERIC CORONAVIRUS DISEASE – Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea

#### WEST OAHU & ISLAND OF OAHU

Under authority granted in Hawaii Revised Statutes §142-2, effective immediately, no live swine originating from points west and north of 89-660 Farrington Highway shall be permitted to move out of Makaha, Waianae, and Nanakuli south and east past 89-660 Farrington Highway on Oahu without the prior written authority of the State Veterinarian.

In addition, no live swine shall be permitted to move off the island of Oahu to any other islands within the State.

Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus (PEDv) which causes diarrhea in all pigs and high mortality levels in baby pigs has been detected in a swine herd in Waianae Valley. PEDv is part of a group of Swine Enteric Coronavirus Diseases (SECD), and is an infectious and transmissible disease of swine. SECD do not infect people and consequently, do not affect public health. The diseases also do not affect the quality and wholesomeness of pork in recovered pigs. SECD such as PEDv have potentially significant economic and swine health consequences if not adequately controlled.

The following conditions shall be in effect for the duration of this quarantine order:

Swine, including all types of pigs, (domestic, farmed animals, pets or feral pigs) shall be prohibited from moving:


1. From points west and north of 89-660 Farrington Highway, Waianae, Hawaii, except when approved by the State Veterinarian and accompanied by a "Permit to Ship" form (DC-8).

2. Off the island of Oahu to any neighbor island except when approved by the State Veterinarian and accompanied by a "Permit to Ship" form (DC-8).


This quarantine shall remain in effect until rescinded.
