When serum is required, please DO NOT send: 1. Whole blood. 2. Extremely hemolyzed and/or lipemic serum.

When swabs are required, please put the swab in Viral Transport Media or in 1 mL of sterile saline. Please do not ship dry swabs or use any of the bacteriological gel transport system.

Shipping Instruction

Serology-Virology Test

The Diagnostic Virology Lab is now offering a substantial discount on FedEx Priority Overnight® shipping service trough pre-printed labels (which are referred to as "Billable Stamps"). The Billable Stamps shipping labels are pre-addresses to the Virology lab and will be provided to you at no cost. Please contact us by e-mail, fax, or telephone and we will send them to you. The minimum number is 10 stamps. The FedEx shipping charges will be added to your invoice.

To use this Billable Stamps for shipping, please fill in your business name, phone number, and date of shipment; Then, peel off the right side of the stamp and fasten it to the shipping box; Retain the left side for your records in case you want to track the shipment.

Serum should be removed from the clot, placed in a separate tube, and packed in a leak proof container with absorbent material. This package should be placed inside of a second container on ice (gel packs). Serum tube should be clearly labeled. Overnight shipping is recommended.

Conjunctival slides for antigen detection should be air dried, placed in a slide holder and shipped overnight without any cold packs. Do not fix slides!

Specimens for PCR testing should be sent as soon after collection as possible with cold packs by overnight service.

Please do not ship samples on Friday.

FAVN Rabies Antibody Titer test

The FAVN test is initiated every Monday and the results are usually ready by Thursday of the same week. Please check with the destination authority to verify pet importation requirements (some countries require 2 titers 30 days apart).

For each test, a separate FAVN Rabies Antibody Submission Form should be filled out, signed by a licensed veterinarian and sent along with 1-2 ml of serum. The veterinarian's signature attests that all the information on the form is correct. The serum should be separated from a clot and placed in a separate test tube. The sample tube should be labeled with the pet's name, owner's last name and the microchip number. Unlabeled samples cannot be processed. Samples should be put inside a plastic bag with absorbent pads and shipped on ice (frozen gel packs). The "FAVN RABIES ANTIBODY TEST" form should be placed inside the package. Samples should not be in transit for more than 2 days.

After the test is completed, the official FAVN Test Report is sent by e-mail or fax either directly to the Veterinary/Quarantine Authorities of the destination country or to the submitting clinic, depending on the specific requirements.
