

Coconut Rhinoceros Beetle Response Update
June 8 - 19, 2015

- Detections
 - On Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPH-HI)
 - 34 adults, 0 larvae detected on-base; 1,780 adults, 1,970 larvae total to date.
 - Off Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam (JBPH-HI)
 - 2 adults, 0 larvae detected off-base; 114 adults total to date.
- Surveillance
 - No new delimiting survey barrel traps were placed and 201 trap services were conducted on 145 total barrel traps during this period.
 - 6 new delimiting survey panel traps were placed and 2,261 trap services were conducted on 2,800 total panel traps during this period.
 - 10 mulch sites were visually surveyed for CRB presence during this period out of 323 mulch piles surveyed to date.
 - No CRB damaged palms were detected and no dead or damaged palms were removed during this period.
 - 2 square mile grids were surveyed during this period out of 308 square miles surveyed to date.
- Outreach
 - A total of 313 persons were provided outreach information and materials during this reporting period out of a total of 62,056 persons contacted since CRB was first detected on 12/23/13.
 - No confirmed CRB reports were called in to the HDOA's 643-PEST hotline.
 - **Beetle Fact:** Pathway: It is believed that this species was introduced to Guam by a gravid female hitchhiking on cargo from Asia (Moore, 2007).
