

# How To Apply

The following documents are required:

## CBB Pesticide Subsidy Application Form PPC17-01

The online form is available on the Hawai'i Department of  
Agriculture website:

Apply for the program annually with your contact  
information, tax map key (TMK) number and other  
information about your farm.

## Original Receipts

Required to provide proof of purchase.

## Driver's License / State Issued ID

Required for proof of identity.

## State and Federal Tax ID's

Your State of Hawai'i General Excise Tax number and  
your Social Security number or Federal Tax ID are  
required to complete Form V-8, which will be provided at  
your appointment.

## Land Lease

Required if your name is not listed as an owner or lessee  
on the TMK information provided by the County  
Real Property Tax Office.

## Farm or Business Invoice

You may bring a blank invoice to request  
reimbursement for your farm or business or HDOA will  
provide one for you.

## HDOA CBB Pesticide Subsidy Program


The Coffee Berry Borer (CBB) Pesticide Subsidy Program was established during the 2014 Legislative Session by Act 105 (HB1514) to assist Hawai'i coffee farmers with the cost of pesticides containing *Beauveria bassiana* (i.e. BotaniGard® and Mycotrol®) for CBB control. The program was extended to June 30, 2021 by Act 065 (HB186) in the 2017 Legislative Session.

Coffee farmers may receive annual reimbursements based on a percentage of the out-of-pocket cost paid for these pesticides:

Pesticide costs incurred 7/1/16 through 6/30/21 are eligible for up to 50% reimbursement.

Annual reimbursement amounts are limited to a maximum of \$600 per year per acre, and \$9,000 per farm per year through 6/30/18 and \$6,000 per year per farm 7/1/18 through 6/30/21.

If you participate in programs to receive a reduced price for *Beauveria bassiana* products, you may still submit your out-of-pocket expenses for reimbursement through this program.
