Chapter 4-86, Hawaii Administrative Rules, entitled “Brake Fluids, Coolants, petroleum Products, and After-Market Additives,” shall be repealed and re-adopted as Chapter 4-186, entitled “Petroleum Products Accounting and Inspection,” except as follows. The summary of the newly proposed rules for Chapter 4-186 is as follows:

1. Section 4-186-4, Definitions
Includes the definition of “gasoline-ethanol blend” to mean a fuel that consists of gasoline and ethanol volume greater than zero percent and less than or equal to ten percent volume.

Updates references to the current published American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) measurement tables.
2. Sections 4-186-5, Incorporation of federal general codes
Updates references to the National Institute of Standards and Technology Handbook 44 and Handbook 130, 2017 editions.
3. Sections 4-186-10, 4-186-11, 4-186-12, and 4-186-13
Updates references for petroleum products, brake fluid, automotive antifreeze coolants and coolants, and lubricants respectively to the current published ASTM specification standards.
