I cannot recall if I sent this to you already, so here it goes again.

The Hawaii Department of Agriculture Pesticides Branch has concluded its review of thiamethoxam in regards to groundwater leachability. After the full groundwater review by the University of Hawaii Water Resources and Research Center, it has been determined that state restricted status will be required. Attached is Dr. Ray's completed review. Based on the chemical's environmental fate characteristics, the Branch requires a mechanism to track the use of amicarbazone. The only manner in which this can be done at this time is through state restriction. Please let me know if you have any questions on the attached document.
