VI. OLD BUSINESS

“Corrections to Proposed Administrative Rules, Chapter 4-161, Hawaii-Grown Industrial Hemp”

1. §4-161-2(a)(5)(A), “If seed importation assistance from the department is *requested* . . . “ was changed to “If seed importation assistance from the department is *authorized* . . . ”
2. §4-161-2(a)(8) added, “A statement that the applicant is the fee simple owner, *lessee, or occupier* of the licensed land area to be used for cultivation . . . “ This change reflects a statutory amendment made in the 2017 legislative session.
3. §4-161-2(c) deleted the provision that applications received after April 1 of any year shall be denied. This change reflects a statutory amendment made in the 2017 legislative session.
4. §4-161-2(e) was amended to make it consistent with subsection (i), which provides that renewal applications shall be due 60 days prior to the expiration of the previous license.
