

<b>Compost Reimbursement Program Fact Sheet</b>	
<b>Program Funding</b>	\$650,000 over two years The program includes FY2021 but the final year is unfunded
<b>State Requirement</b>	W-9 form Sample invoice Proof of compliance – Hawaii Compliance Express or similar
<b>Reimbursement Limit</b>	Reimbursement amount will include transportation costs Reimbursement amounts will be issued on a first-come first-served basis Amount of reimbursement will not exceed \$50,000 per qualified purchaser per fiscal year Any funds not disbursed will be rolled over to the following year
<b>Program Processor or Reseller Qualifications</b>	Compost must be purchased from a certified processor, dealer, retailer, or wholesaler licensed to do business in the State Certified Hawaii processors will be limited to those companies regulated under the Department of Health Solid Waste Management Program
<b>Reimbursement Rate</b>	Amount of reimbursement will be up to 50% of cost of compost incurred for the purchase of the compost
<b>Documentation</b>	Year 1 (FY 2019) Documentation of costs from July 1, 2018 through and including June 30, 2019 for compost purchased from qualified producers or distributors  Year 2 (portion of FY 2020) Documentation of costs from July 1, 2019 through and including March 30, 2020 for compost purchased from qualified producers or distributors
<b>Forms (A &amp; B) Due Date</b>	Year 1 – December 31, 2019 Year 2 – March 31, 2020
