Statistics on Papayas State of Hawaii, 2017-2021

The value of utilized production for Hawaii's papayas was estimated at \$8.5 million in 2021, a 177% improvement from the previous year. Total production increased to 13,400 million pounds, 62% more than the previous year. Utilized production jumped 77% to 12,330 million pounds.

Papaya bearing acreage statewide remained unchanged and drove yield per acre up 62% to 22,300 pounds per acre in 2021. The volume of papaya harvested but not sold decreases to 1.1 million pounds, 20% less than 2020. Papaya growers received a record average price of 69 cents per pound for the fruit, 25 cents higher than in 2020.

Growers noted good growing conditions in 2021, a reversal in inclement weather events in the past few years. However, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to challenge the papaya industry with insufficient labor, increased material input costs, declines in air freight availability, high shipping costs, and also affected consumer buying habits.¹

Over the five-year period from 2017-2021, the value of utilized production of papayas decreased 10% while utilized production dropped a staggering 44.6% in the same time period. Overall, 2021 has been an improvement from the last three crop years.




Chart 1: Utilized Hawaii Papaya Production: Value and Volume, 2017-2021
