Fresh Basil Statistics State of Hawaii, 2021

Hawaii fresh basil production is estimated at 12.3 million pounds, valued at a record \$29.4 million in 2021. Compared with the previous crop year, volume and value measures increased 24% and 31% respectively. Hawaii basil growers managed to deliver this new record with higher yields (27%), higher market prices on slightly fewer acres of land, and with a smaller workforce. Approximately 400 acres of farmland were dedicated to planting fresh basil (down 2% from the previous year).

The main challenge for most basil growers is the availability of experienced and dedicated farm workers. Some growers managed to hire more foreign workers (mainly from Philippines) through the USDA H-2A visa program for temporary workers, but the total number of basil workers was still down in 2021. The collection of basil farms provided employment opportunities for nearly 102 hired workers, down slightly by 10% from 2020. Many departing farmworkers reportedly pivoted to non-farming jobs during the course of the year.

Sweet (Italian) and Asian (Thai) are the two primary types of basil grown in Hawaii. In 2021, Sweet basil accounted for an estimated 7.4 million pounds (about 60%) of the 12.3 million pounds harvested in total. Asian (Thai) basil accounted for the remaining balance. An estimated 99.3% of all locally produced basil is exported to the U.S Mainland and Canada. In 2021, Sweet and Asian basil fetched \$2.72 and \$1.91 per pound respectively in the export markets, up eleven cents (4%) and twenty cents (12%) correspondingly over the previous year. Nevertheless, the export markets commanded much higher prices than those in the local markets for comparable products.




Chart 1: Fresh Basil – Total Production and Farm Value, 2000-2021
