IV. Presentation by **Public Testimony – Marcus Serrano**, who echoed Megan Villa's, Hemp Consultants: hemp consultant, findings, and recommendations.

Discussion:

Ms. Neal expressed concerns about controlling invasive species if checking out and transporting heavy equipment between farms. Ms. Neal supported a cannabinoid hemp task force.

Mr. Dalgamouni supported a separate cannabinoid task force and interagency collaboration regarding the interim rules. Mr. Dalgamouni suggested to pause on any new rulemaking.

Mr. Bence related that he votes no to the recommendations in the presentation and suggested a need for a completely new task force. Mr. Bence commented that it is his understanding that the hemp task force is to engage with farmers and make the recommendations.

DAG Goff clarified that the task force is tasked with making their own recommendations and can hold more meetings if necessary. Currently, the task force members are discussing the consultant's recommendations.

Mr. Cheng shared that the medical cannabis dispensaries on Oahu have equipment to process cannabidiol (CBD).

Mr. Wong related how pests are controlled when taking tractors to different farms.

Ms. Neal responded to Mr. Cheng's comment and indicated that she does not want to be lumped into medical or adult-cannabis businesses.
